


7. INSERT FAT PIN #11 INTO GTX BLADE (NOTE CORRECT ORIENTATION). FROM STEP #4.



8. INSTALL GTX INTO TRIGGER HOUSING. INSURE THAT STRUT #5 FALLS INTO GROOVE #18 IN GTX. REINSTALL PIVOT PIN #9 THROUGH HOUSING AND GTX. REPLACE E-CLIP #2. LUBRICATE POINTS OF CONTACT APPROPRIATELY. CHECK FOR FREE AND SMOOTH ROTATION OF GTX AROUND PIVOT PIN. REMOVE AND CLEAR ANY INTERFERENCE. ADJUST GTX SCREWS ACCORDING TO INSTRUCTIONS WITH 0.050" ALLEN WRENCH (PROVIDED) AS NEEDED.



9. REASSEMBLE GUN, TEST, AND REFINE GTX ADJUSTMENTS ACCORDING TO INSTRUCTIONS.

WARNING: WHEN SHOOTING WITH THE GTX FOR THE FIRST TIME, DON'T EVEN <u>TOUCH</u> THE TRIGGER WITHOUT FIRST POINTING THE MUZZLE IN A SAFE DIRECTION. <u>YOU WILL</u> BE SURPRISED!
